TOURNAMENT NOTICE TO ALL PLAYERS

- All players entering the 2010 SA Nationals must have a valid SATA number and be a registered Tournament Player (Junior, Senior or Veteran)
- To obtain a number and become a registered member log on to www.satennis.co.za
- Only on-line entries will be accepted via the SATA website
- The rules and regulations allow for the Main Draw to be reduced to a 24 Draw depending on entries received from top touring players ranked within the top 300 on the ATP / WTA Rankings

- The Men's Singles winner will receive a Wild Card into the Main Draw of the SA Open to be played at Montecasino from 1 – 7 February 2010
- The Men's Singles finalist will receive a Wild Card into the Qualifying competition of the SA Open to be played at Montecasino from 30 – 31 January 2010
- Only South African citizens or holders of South African residence permits will be permitted to enter
- General SATA Rules and Regulations and Code of Conduct as per the ITF will be in effect
- In the event of the tournament being cancelled due to weather, players will receive the round losers points and round losers prize money that they have reached at the time that the tournament is cancelled
- A players party for the Main Draw players will be held on Tuesday evening along with a social/pro am event at the club
